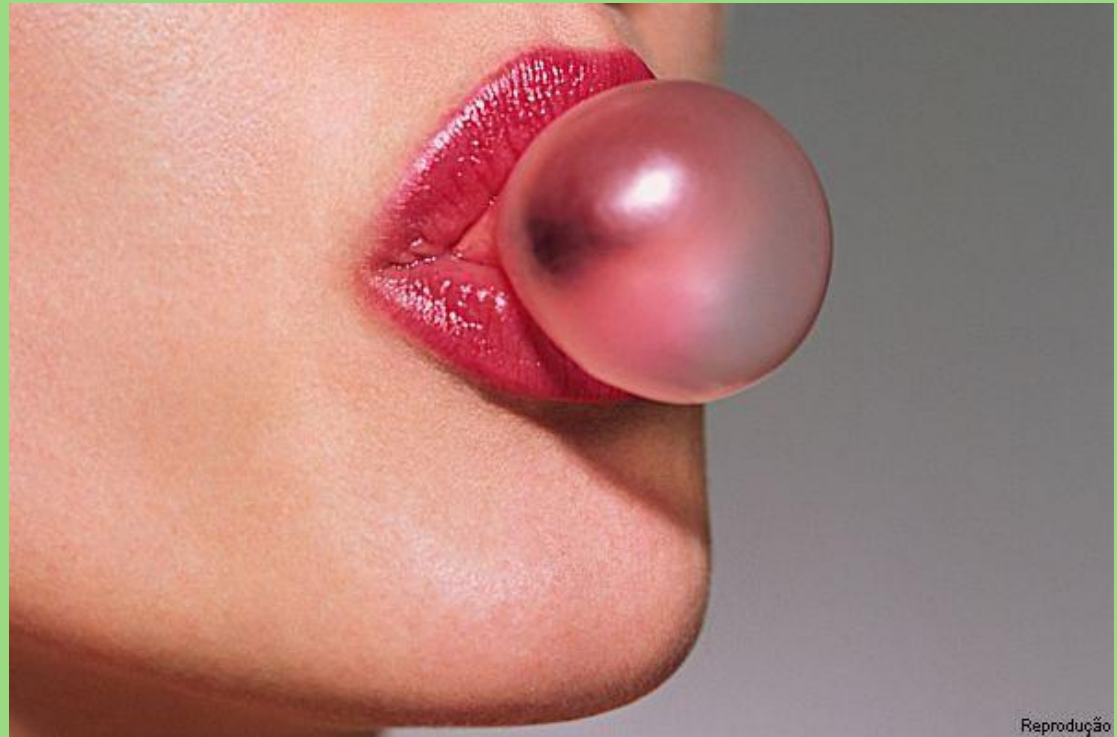

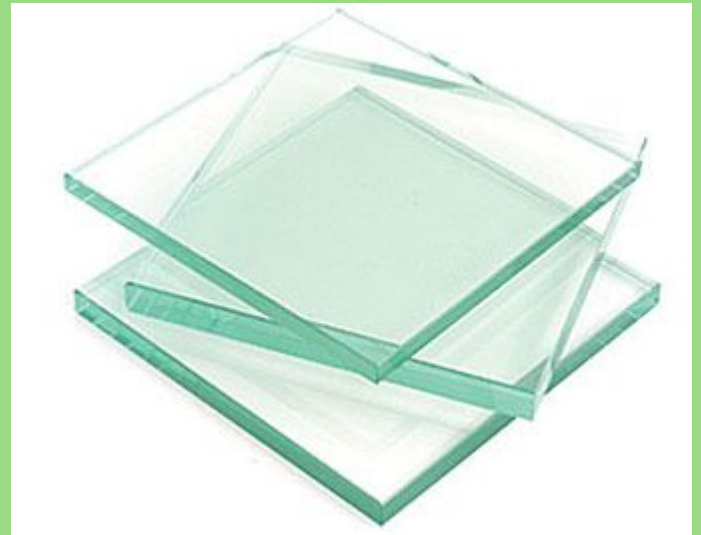

why is it important to recycle

It is important to recycle because besides saving natural resources (all manufacture was produced with materials taken from the earth), the reuse of materials reduces the amount of waste produced, which is good for the planet and good for all living beings

Recycling is the process that aims to turn used materials into new products for reuse. By this process, materials that would otherwise go to waste permanent can be reused.

Reducing return to original form or normal.

Reuse provide a usefull new materials that are often considered useless.

Some things that people can do to recycle that stand out:

The soda bottles are transformed into fabric to make jeans. A ton of recycled plastic saves 130 pounds of oil after recycled. Plastic can still turn carpets, hoses, ropes, bags, fenders. Recycling one ton of paper saves 22 trees, consumes 71% less energy and pollutes the air less than 74%. Manufacture it various kinds of paper can be recycled 7 times or more. These are just some of the numerous benefits that recycling provides to society, the economy and the environment.
